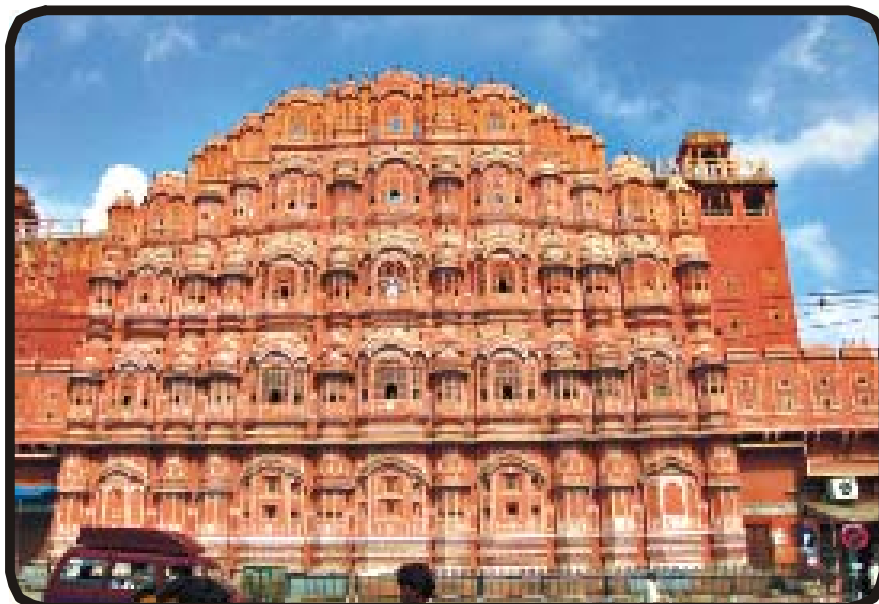
Invitation from the Conference Scientific Chairs

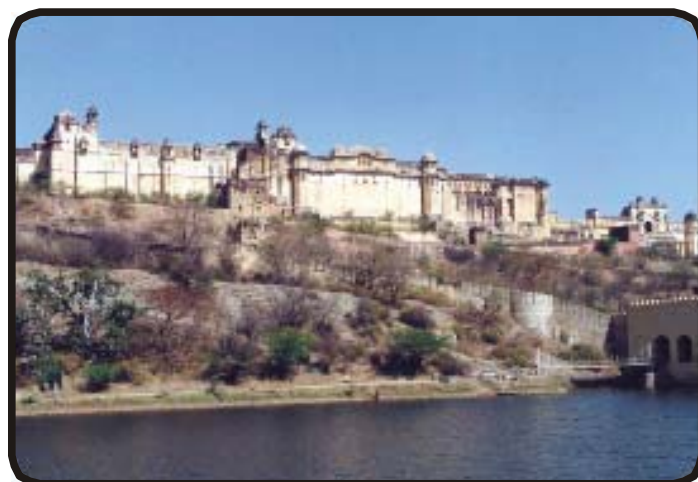
